Unified GUI Interface for Development and Task Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Developers can now view work assigned to them directly within WDS, eliminating the need to navigate elsewhere to perform their work. ▪ Utilizes new Worktray feature of MKS Integrity Manager.
Enhanced MKS Integrity Manager Integration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ New Implementer server-based architecture allows the Implementer and Integrity Manager integration workload to be placed on either the iSeries or Intel platform. ▪ A new Change Lock command allows users to write their own scripts to manage the assignment of issues to source and objects. ▪ New Create Issue command allows creation of issues directly within Implementer or from a command line.
New Email Command	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Additional notifications can be sent to targeted users to improve communication within IT and the user community. ▪ This command can be used outside of Implementer to meet a variety of needs.
Independent Auxiliary Pools (iASPs) Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Improved ability to handle complex high available (HA) scenarios where iASPs play a role.
Simplified Promotion Diagnostics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Spurious escape and diagnostic messages have been eliminated to assist in promotion troubleshooting.
Revised License Checker	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Temporary keys now issue warning messages eliminating unplanned downtime due to license key expiration. ▪ Improved host notification of receiver licensing failure aids in license key troubleshooting. ▪ New license keys are required.
Release Management Improvements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Release management deployments can now target DVD media using the iSeries DVD writer. ▪ MKS Integrity Manager can now be used to track software releases providing full release-level visibility within Integrity Manager.
Enhanced Domino Integration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ New database signing feature eliminates manual post-promotion activities. ▪ Expanded use of Domino APIs improves check out and promotion throughput.
Enhanced LANSAs Integration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Enhanced impact analysis for files defined outside of LANSAs ("Other" files) ensures maximum application up time. ▪ Visual LANSAs integration takes advantage of new LANSAs APIs to ensure release-to-release stability and reduced administrative overhead.
